

PFAS-Free Packaging Materials Policy

Effective Date: January 1, 2025

This document outlines Plastics 2000's policy regarding the use of packaging materials in relation to PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances). Our commitment to environmental safety and regulatory compliance necessitates strict controls to ensure that all packaging materials are free from PFAS chemicals.

Policy Statements

1. All packaging materials used by the Plastics 2000—including primary, secondary, and tertiary packaging such as pallets, cartons, tapes, labels, inner bags, liners, shrink wrap, and dividers—are confirmed to be free of PFAS chemicals to the best of our knowledge.
2. No PFAS chemicals have been intentionally added at any stage of the production or packaging process.
3. Based on supplier declarations and internal compliance reviews, all packaging materials comply with PFAS-free standards and applicable regional regulations, including any current bans or restrictions.

Compliance and Review

This policy is based on current regulatory standards and supplier-provided documentation. The company will continue to monitor developments in PFAS regulations and update this policy as necessary. Periodic reviews will be conducted to ensure ongoing compliance and to verify supplier adherence to PFAS-free requirements.
